Trustee Access and/or Review of Personal Interment Records

Under the California Public Records Act, local agencies (such as the District) and their officials (such as the Trustees) are entitled to access public records on the same basis as any other person. Govt C §7921.305 However, when authorized to do so as part of their official duties, local agency officials (Trustees) may access public records of their own agency (District) that are otherwise exempt. Dixon v Superior Court (2009) 170 CA4th 1271, 1276; Marylander v Superior Court (2000) 81 CA4th 1119, 1125. This means that individual Trustees are only entitled to access, inspect and/or review those District records that are formally associated with their official duties and responsibilities, such as litigation documents, public works contracts, resolutions, policies, etc.

However, I do not believe Trustees have a legitimate reason to access inspect and/or review personal interment records, and particularly those where the family has requested the details of a deceased loved one's interment records be kept confidential.

Basically, government officials are prohibited from obtaining any special privileges that are not afforded to the general public, unless such special privileges are associated with their official duties and responsibilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these fund transfers are the result of interment costs and contract refunds incurred for the months of November 1, 2023 to January 31, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Manager of the District is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Treasurer of Riverside County and to the Auditor-Controller of Riverside County.
